



How to separate and take out household garbage

Separation decreases waste.
Mixing makes waste.

● **Garbage is collected on all National Holidays**, (except for May 3-5, and January 1-3) See the garbage collection calendar for details on collection days.

◆ Take garbage out by 8:00 am on the designated day.

◆ Only designated garbage bag, and ensure the top of the bag is tied. →

◆ Separate garbage properly, and take it out to the designated collection site.

◆ Take out garbage on the collection day.

Overized garbage

Individual purchased garbage collection or carry-in garbage

Items that are too large for the designated bag

Collecting at home

Taking to Kurinpia Kyouritsu waste facility directly

Individual purchased garbage collection

Reservation by telephone is necessary.

Carry-in garbage (charges apply)

Please separate the oversized garbage in combustible and non-combustible, when you bring it directly to the garbage reception counter.

In the case of bringing oversized garbage directly

Bring combustible and non-combustible oversized garbage separately.

To combustible garbage reception counter (scale)

To non-combustible garbage reception counter (scale)

To oversized garbage processing facilities

Combustible oversized garbage

Non-combustible oversized garbage

Examples: Futons, Carpets, Wooden chairs, Wooden desks, Large wooden furniture, Bicycles, Skis, Snowshoes/scoops, Swings, Sofas (with springs), Metal shelves.

Carry-in garbage

Carry-in garbage directly to Kurinpia Kyouritsu waste facility.

- Large quantities of household garbage due to relocation or other reasons
- Ashes from residential wood stoves
- Litter sand for pet
- Deceased pets
- Pruned branches • trees • bamboo

How to dispose carry-in garbage

- There are reception counters for Combustible garbage and Non-combustible garbage
- Please separate garbage according to category.
- Please follow staff's instructions.
- If you need any help, please ask the staff.
- It is not necessary to use the designated bag for carry-in garbage.
- Please be cautious of vehicles during the moving season from March to May and other long holidays.

Saturday and Sunday of the first and the third week	9am - 11:30am
Carry-in garbage	180 yen per 10kg
Deceased pet	2,000 yen per carcass
Free	Newspaper, magazine, cardboard

Items subject to Home Appliance Recycling Law

- Air conditioners
- Refrigerators (Freezers)
- Washing machines
- Laundry dryers
- PC's
- Motorbikes
- Fire extinguishers

Items not accepted

- Car parts
- Toxic waste
- Agricultural materials
- Gravel
- Concrete waste
- Stones
- Waste wood

Industrial waste cannot be disposed of in this way.

Garbage from business activities are not accepted.
