## Hamilton's spindletree

## (Euonymus hamiltonianus)

It is a deciduous shrub, growing 6 to 10 meters high and 10 to 40 centimeters in diameter. The bark is greyish-white, with fine vertical streaks and fissures on older trees. The green and finely serrated leaves are long and oval with pointed tips. From May to June, many cymes emerge from everywhere on the branches that have grown that year, and greenish-white flowers bloom one after another. Its fruits ripen in autumn, and when they split, vermilion seeds hang from inside.
